

My first summer in the Sierra Nevada Mountains was a transformative experience that ignited a lifelong passion for nature.


Through my drawings and photographs, I hope to inspire others to appreciate the beauty and wonder of the natural world and to embrace their responsibility as stewards of this precious planet.




