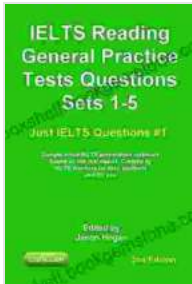

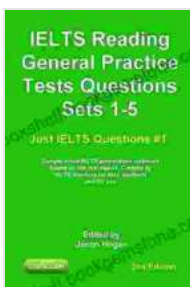
The IELTS Reading section is designed to test your ability to read and understand written English. The section consists of three passages, each with a different topic.

1. **Passage 1:** A short text, such as a news article or a magazine article.
2. **Passage 2:** A long text, such as an academic article or a book chapter.
3. **Passage 3:** A long text, such as an academic article or a book chapter.

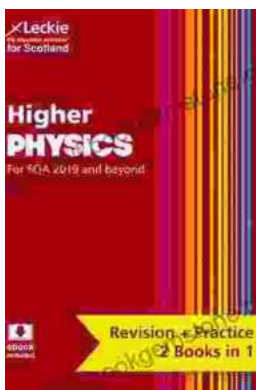
